CALENDAR FOR SUMMER CAMP 2019

The first day of Summer Camp is **May 28, 2019**.

The last day of Summer Camp is **August 6, 2019**.

We will be **closed** on Thursday, July 4, 2019 in observance of Independence Day.

Registration Requirements:

- Registration Form (submit online through Sandbox)
- \$125.00 Registration Fee per child for Summer Camp
- Current Immunization Record

Summer Camp Tuition

- \$130/week – 1 child
- \$120/week – each additional sibling
- Tuition is due on Monday of the week of care
- A Late Payment Fee of \$10 will be added each Tuesday

Early Drop-Off/Late Pick-Up Fees

- Early Drop-Off Fee - \$1/minute
- Late Pick-Up Fee - \$1/minute

Summer Camp is 10 weeks long. You have 1 week of vacation time that you do not have to pay tuition. If you use more than 1 week, you will still be required to pay the weekly tuition for the time your child is absent.

Tuition payments are due each Monday of the week of care.
We accept cash, check, VISA, Mastercard, and American Express
In order to hold your child's spot, your account must stay current.

The fee for a returned check is \$25.00 per check. If we receive more than 2 returned checks on an account, cash will be required.

Early Drop-Off/Late Pick-Up

This fee is for any time prior to 6:30am and past 6:30pm and will be \$1.00 per minute. The fee will be reflected on your weekly statement as “Early Drop Off-Fee” and/or “Late Pick-Up Fee.” We will use the time on the iPad that you sign your children in/out on as the Planet 82 time.

Medications

Please let us know if your child needs to receive prescription medication during the time that he/she is with us. We will not dispense medicine without a completed medication form, which can be requested from the office. Medication should be brought in by the parent in the original, non-breakable container and marked clearly with the child’s name, name of medication, and dosage your child needs. Over the counter medications will not be given.

Accidents/Emergencies

In case of accident or injury, you will be notified immediately. In the event that we are unable to reach you or your designated emergency contacts, your child will be taken to the nearest designated facility for initial emergency care. In the event of an accident, we will call 911 for immediate assistance.

Drop Off/Pick Up

Only a parent, guardian, or authorized person on your child’s registration form may sign out your child. A student cannot sign out another student. We will only release your child to someone who is currently on your pick-up list. If you need to make other arrangements, you can provide it in writing, phone call, email, or fax using your child’s personal security code you provided on the application.

Lunch/Snacks

Your child is required to bring his/her own lunch each full day. This lunch should be a cold lunch. Reheating items will not be allowed by state law. Be sure to pack a nutritious lunch with a drink. A morning snack and afternoon snack will be provided each day. We have a daily schedule of the snacks we will be serving. If your child does not eat that snack or needs more to eat, please put something extra in his/her lunch box.

Items from Home

Your child should not bring money, toys, games, stuffed animals, cell phones, electronics, or any type of gadgets to Planet 82.

Down Time

Your child will be provided a mat to rest on. You will need to provide a blanket or beach towel for your child. No pillows or pillow pets are allowed because of a potential lice problem. These will need to be brought from home on Monday and taken home each Friday to be washed.

Water Days And Field Trips

“Water Days” may be scheduled during the summer. Please remember on Water Days to send a swimsuit, t-shirt to cover swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, and dry clothes. If your child does not bring swim clothes, he/she cannot get wet. We are planning a few field trips as well. We will wear our Planet 82 t-shirts on all of our trips. Your child will be transported by church bus to the field trip location. A form for each trip will need to be signed and on file at Planet 82 to be able to ride the bus.

Dress Code for Summer Camp And Full Days

Students are expected to dress appropriately at Planet 82. We will be playing indoors and outdoors each day. Please be sure to send your child in clothes that can get dirty. Shorts must be an appropriate length of 3 inches from the top of the knee (no short shorts), and tops should cover the torso and not be low-cut. If students are not dressed appropriately, they will be asked to change clothes. NO flip flops except on Water Days.

Discipline

We will use clear instruction and positive reinforcement to encourage appropriate behavior. There may be times, however, when discipline for inappropriate behavior is necessary. Discipline will not be associated with food, rest, or restroom privileges. No physical form of corporal punishment will be administered by Planet 82 staff. Extreme discipline problems will be referred to the Director. The rules for Planet 82 are based on values that are important for children to learn.

PLANET 82 VALUES

- LOVE – Love God with all your heart and love those around you as you do yourself. Treat people with kindness and mercy - like you want to be treated!
- RESPONSIBILITY – Take care of your domain (classroom, personal belongings, etc.) by being neat and organized. Treat the planet God made with respect and Planet 82 with respect!
- OBEDIENCE – Obey your leaders and the rules of Planet 82.
- WISDOM – Learning and growing at Planet 82 by cultivating the ten character qualities found below will help your child thrive at Planet 82, at school, in your home and in all of life!
 - ♥ GROWING IN **OBEDIENCE** – Obedience is doing what I’m told to do, when I’m told to do it, with a right heart attitude.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **ATTENTIVENESS** – Attentiveness is listening with my ears, eyes and heart.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **SELF CONTROL** – Self Control is keeping my mind, mouth and movements from going in bad directions.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **DILIGENCE** – Diligence is working hard to accomplish a task.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **WISDOM** – Wisdom is aiming my life toward what God says is the right direction.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **KINDNESS** – Kindness is treating people with love and respect.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **FORGIVENESS** – Forgiveness is responding to hurtful people in loving ways.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **HONESTY** – Honesty is communicating with truthful words and in truthful ways.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **LOVE** – Love is sacrificing myself for the good of others.
 - ♥ GROWING IN **WORSHIP** – Worship is celebrating the glory of God by loving King Jesus with all my might.

PLANET 82 RULES

- Do not stray from your group without permission from your leader.
- Do not run in the halls.
- Do not use corrupt communication (foul language, cruel language, dirty jokes, etc...)
- Do not touch or take other people's belongings without asking.
- Do not talk when your leader is talking.
- Do not do anything to hurt (physically or verbally) or scare another student at Planet 82.
- Do not harm the church property in any way.

The following consequences will be enforced if the rules are broken:

- **1st Consequence: Warning**
- **2nd Consequence: Time-out during regular gym or playtime**
- **3rd Consequence: Time-out in office with Director**
- **4th Consequence: Phone call to parents** – The Director will phone the parent and explain the situation. Parent will speak with the child and then the Director to determine if the child needs to be picked up immediately or removed from the normal activities of Planet 82. If the child remains at Planet 82, he/she will take part in a special project (service project or character-aimed writing project) for the remainder of the day.

More serious situations will follow the protocol below:

If a student physically harms another student during Planet 82, the student will immediately be taken to the office.

- The Director will interview the teachers and students involved.
- The parents of all involved will be contacted.
- The Director will schedule a parent/Director meeting to discuss the consequences. Depending on the severity of the aggression, the student may be suspended from Planet 82
